Since our inception, "Creating a Sanctuary Within" has been one of OM Sanctuary's guiding principles. It centers around the idea of disconnecting from the ever-present technology driven world to reconnect with one's innate rhythms and inner wisdom. This connection occurs when life quiets and slows down, allowing individuals to nurture their body, mind, spirit and natural connections.

In response to the challenges posed by the pandemic and its aftermath full of delays, we took the opportunity to reevaluate and enhance our strategic plan.

Over the past few years, we've embarked on a phased journey to restore our nearly thirty-year-old buildings, as well as update our rooms. Dreams do come true. After wading through the delays, we are thrilled to share that this fall our contractors are now undertaking the exciting next steps in expanding our Renewal Center with the expected completion in late spring of 2024. This expansion will include open-air treatments such as: massage, hydrotherapy mineral baths, and a Tea Garden for lectures and meditation.

Additionally, we're dedicated to enhancing our natural surroundings. We are actively developing our nature preserve, which will feature native plants, wildlife, a ceremonial labyrinth, self-guided forest bathing signage, and a network of trails.

Furthermore, OM Sanctuary is building out forest destination gazebos within the woods, providing tranquil spaces for personal activities like yoga, meditation, and journaling. These platforms will be sanctuary within a sanctuary, where guests can deepen their connection with nature and inner peace.



*Woodland Cottages* had major disrepair and structural compromise that were addressed and completed! Repairs included:

- Addition of Maple floors
- Interior and exterior paint
- Addition of Trex porch flooring
- Showers
- Lawn for classes
- Path with stormwater retention rock ditch and french draining system
- Plumbing, HVAC and Electrical

To offer outdoor wellness sessions, OM Sanctuary is expanding the Renewal Center with outdoor gardens, massage platforms, and hydrotherapy mineral baths.

During the pandemic our doors were forced closed, this addition will allow us to stay open with the outdoor alternatives . We are implementing eco-friendly practices by **removing impervious** surfaces and enhancing stormwater retention on site. *This expansion is fully funded by a loan*.

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
